General

His event is designed to have the spirit of appreciation for the backyard BBQ masters, a level of competition that makes the competitors raise their game, and the baseline expectation that everyone involved should have a good time.

The Teams

Each team will have a team captain and up to three assistants. The names of these four participants must be recorded on the entry form. Each team will have a Team name and can have some spirit in setting up their area. The team captain will be responsible for the entire team. Each team will receive 2 full racks of ribs and 1 chicken. Each team must bring their own supplies.

The Pit

The area will be up to 12x18ft. If you will fit in a 12x12 area, please let me know. Your pit can use any type of Fuel or heat. No electricity can be provided to the Pt Area. You will need to bring your own generator if one is needed. Each pit can be used for only one team. Please consider having easy-ups or some other shelter. Cars will need to be parked in the staffing area.

Cooking

Cooking cannot begin cooking until 7:00AM. Cooking will continue until 2:45PM

Each team will receive 3 foam boxes labeled for secrecy.

Each team will turn in 6 portions of Ribs at 3:00PM.(we will discuss this at the meeting)

Each team will turn in 6 portions of Chicken at 3:00PM. (we will discuss this at the meeting)

The ribs and chicken containers turned in can only have lettuce or parsley as a garnish. No other garnishes, puddled sauces, or any other identifiable markings can be in the turn-in containers. You may have sauce on the meats, just no puddles to dip into. One on these infractions will create a disqualification.

The Judging

There will be 3 judges. A complete set of judge's rules will be published. Scoring will be based on Presentation 20%, Tenderness 35%, and Taste 45%. The scores will be tabulated and a winner declared. All results will be final.

Prizes

There will be a Champion and a Runner-up. The Champion will receive \$200.00 cash prize, a trophy, and bragging rights for a year!! Runner-up will received \$100.00 and a trophy.
